Even before being born she was different from everyone else.



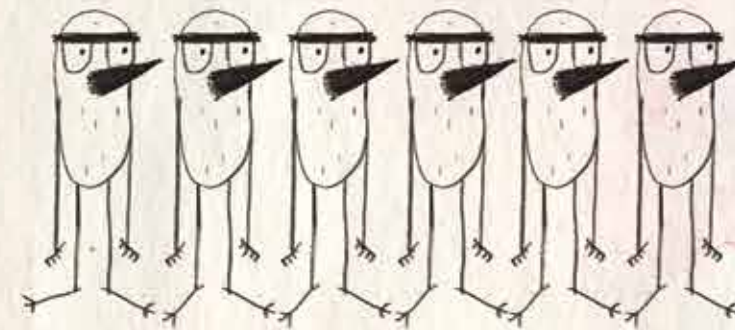
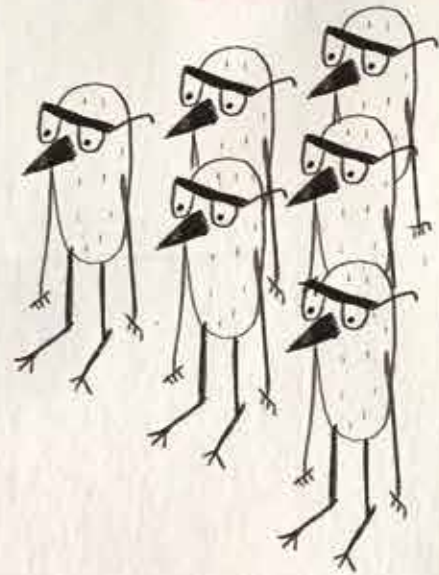
She was **PINK** and everyone else was white.

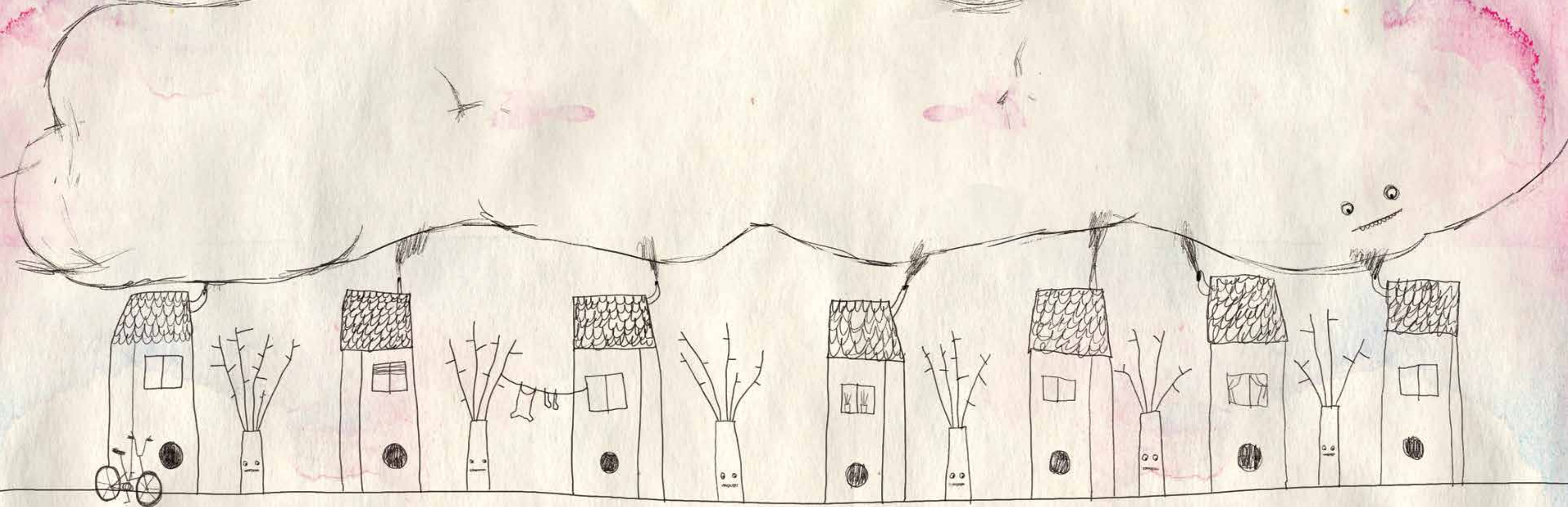


What other differences can you find?
