—Neeeeeeext!

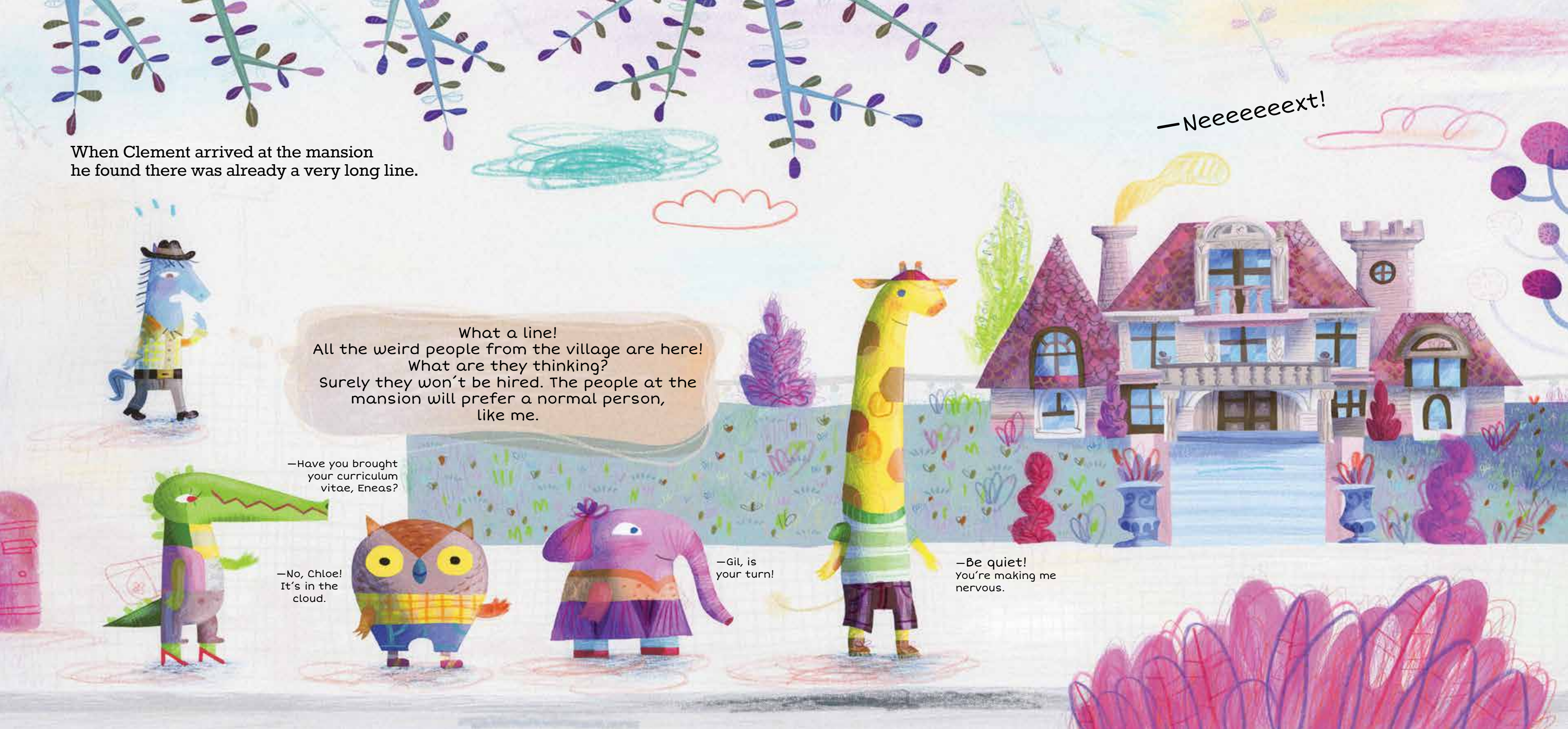
What a line!

long neck!**

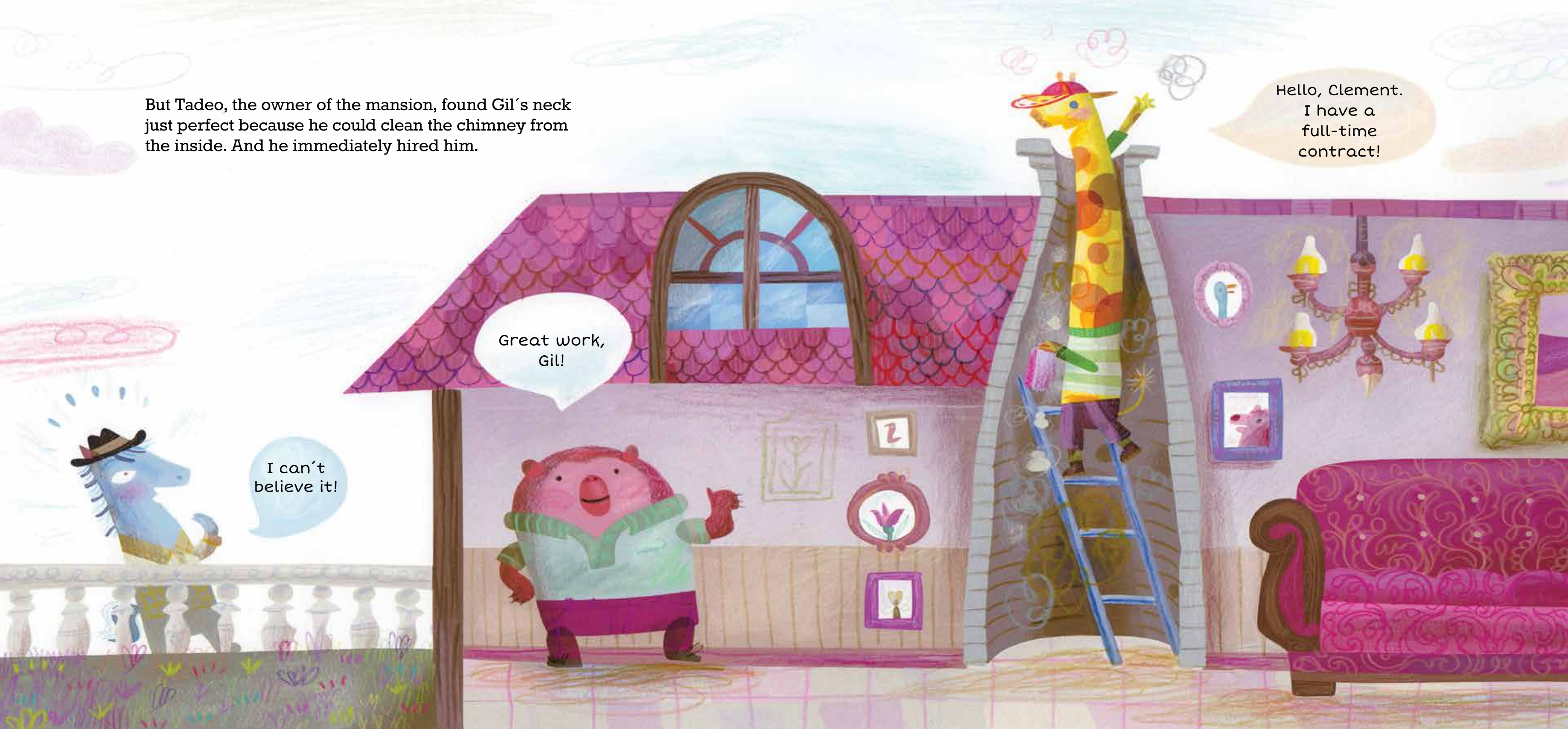
What a shame! Who will take him on?
